Rosé

#437 Château D' Esclans, "Whispering Angel", 2010, Provence, France 36
(*Grenache, Rolle, Cinsault, Syrah & Mourvèdre*)

Château D' Esclans produces a beautiful light rosé from Provence capturing fresh aromas, outstanding flavors and a whisper of fruit yet bone dry in character. There is no oak flavor and if not drinking on its own will pair nicely with raw seafood, cheeses, salads, lightly cooked fish, salmon and lightly grilled meats.

White

#431 Fiano di Avellino, Colli di Lapio di Romano Clelia, 2009, Campania 52

This wine is at least 85 percent of the indigenous Fiano grape in the classical area just northeast of Avellino near the village of Lapio. This wine is vinified in stainless steel, has vibrant acidity and has peach and melon aromatics. Colli di Lapio is a practicing organic estate. The wine is dry, medium to full bodied and is recommended with heavier fish dishes.

#421 Grüner Veltliner, Domaine Wachau, Smaragd, 2007, Wachau, Austria 49

Austria's Grüner Veltliner has emerged as one of the most recent additions to the iconic wines of the world. Gruner Veltliner has an astonishing minerality and bright acidity, expect a fresh, slightly vegetal scented wine with notes of flowers and white pepper. Smaragd wines are produced from grapes harvested slightly late thus producing richer wines that may retain a touch of residual sugar. A great wine with oysters, raw or lightly cooked fish, cured meats, salads, vegetables and many other dishes,

Red

#303 Tinta Roriz Blend, Callabriga, 2008, Douro, Portugal 40

The Douro region has long been known for their world famous fortified wines of Oporto. Recently dry wines from the Douro have gained international acclaim for their unique flavors that represent quality modern winemaking with an old world soul. Callabriga's red blend of Tinta Roriz (*aka as Tempranillo*), Touriga Franca and Touriga Nacional produce intense red and purple shaded wines with complex aromas and a touch of oak & spice. It is a balanced full bodied wine with good tannins and a rich prolonged finish.

#229 Cabernet Sauvignon, Faust, 2007, Rutherford, Napa Valley 89

Lush Napa Valley fruit, toasted oak and spice that complement one another beautifully on the nose is what this Cabernet is all about. Bold and powerful yet elegant and concentrated in flavor. Faust is the second label of Quintessa winery and was rated by The New York Times #1 Napa Valley Cabernet under \$100 in 2011.

Interesting Red

#111 Shiraz, Good Earth Winery, Brio, 2009, Nashik Valley, India 28

A reserve Shiraz from India's Western Nashik Valley, a temperate meso-climate about 120 miles inland from the Indian Ocean. Brio is made from Shiraz grapes first planted in India 3000 years ago. The wine is ruby-hued, medium bodied, fruity, peppery and slightly smoky.
